**Main hazards:** Flammable. Harmful by inhalation. Irritating to eyes and skin.

- Skin contact:** Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.
- Eye contact:** Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Consult a doctor.
- Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting. Wash out mouth with water. Consult a doctor.
- Inhalation:** Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so.

**5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES**

- Extinguishing media:** Carbon dioxide. Dry chemical powder. Alcohol or polymer foam.
- Exposure hazards:** Flammable. In combustion emits toxic fumes of carbon dioxide / carbon monoxide.
- Protection of fire-fighters:** Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.
